



ICS-100: Introduction to Incident Command System

Description: ICS 100 describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System. It also explains the relationship between ICS and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

Audience: Persons involved with emergency planning, response or recovery efforts (All POD staff/volunteers).

NIMS Compliance: Persons involved with emergency planning, response or recovery efforts (All POD staff/volunteers).

This course is divided into five (5) instructional lessons and a post test. Each lesson will take approximately 20 to 50 minutes to complete. The time necessary to complete this course should not exceed five (5) hours in length.

Receiving Credit: To receive credit for this course, you must complete all of the lessons and pass the posttest. The last lesson provides instructions on how to complete the posttest. The posttest must be taken online through the FEMA website and then you must register in order to receive FEMA certification.
